Laura Pedraza is the Development Director for the Children's Home of Stockton. Originally from Southern California, she moved to Northern California 4½ years ago and currently resides in Brentwood with her family and two dogs. Having a B.A. in Communications with an emphasis in Mass Media has led her in many positive directions and she's found a passion for working in the nonprofit world, currently making a difference at CHS.

Children's Home of Stockton (CHS) provides a home away from home for those children who need it most, as its mission is to give at-risk youth an opportunity for a productive life through treatment and education in a safe, nurturing environment. It is one of the largest social services organizations in Stockton and the only licensed Short-Term Residential Therapeutic Program (STRTP) in San Joaquin County. It is Medi-Cal certified as a Specialty Mental Health Provider and offers Transition Aftercare services. CHS has served approximately 200 at-risk youth each year in California, for over 137 years.
