Melinda's passion for the voting process is aligned with San Joaquin County's goals of conducting fair, impartial, accurate, secure and transparent elections, and increasing participation and civic literacy. In this way, Melinda considers herself an "elections evangelist".

Prior to moving to San Joaquin County, she worked in the San Mateo County Elections Office, participating in every aspect of the voter registration and election administration process

Melinda graduated from the University of California, Berkeley with a bachelor's degree in political science with a minor in public policy. She holds the California Professional Election Administrator Credential from the California Association of Clerks and Election Officials (CACEO) and the National Association of Election Officials. Melinda currently serves on the CACEO Fiscal Group Subcommittee and, as Registrar, represents the County as a member of EI-ISAC, Election Infrastructure Information Sharing and Analysis Center, a program funded by the Department of Homeland Security.
