Today's Speaker is Rev. Wayne G. Richardson From the Gospel Center Rescue Mission

Wayne serves as Chief Executive Officer at the Gospel Center Rescue Mission which serves the Homeless of San Joaquin County, California with seven distinct programs serving over 1,000 men, women and children each day at a Stockton based campus. He arrived at the Gospel Center Rescue Mission in August 2016 having served Faith Farm Ministries as its Chief Operating Officer and Director of Development and Programs. Faith Farm Ministries is a three campus, free Christian nine-month resident addiction regeneration program with 450 beds.



Wayne's background also includes serving in leadership positions at the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association, Christian Broadcasting Network's Operation Blessing International, United States Military Academy's West Point Association of Graduates, Southeastern University, and Mountainside Management – his family's property management business in the Hudson Valley, New York.

Service to his country comprises a 23-year Army Active and Reserve career, which includes six years of command and leading multiple Army Engineer unit deployments to Korea and Panama.

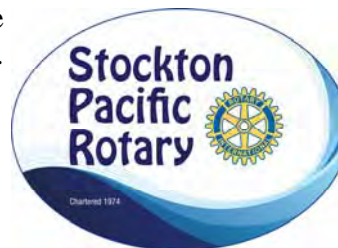
